**ICSC FOUNDATION DONATES TO THE
AMERICAN RED CROSS FOR HAITI RELIEF**

New York (February 2, 2010) – The International Council of Shopping Centers (ICSC) Foundation is pleased to announce the donation in the amount of \$5,000 to the Cruz Roja Americana, Capítulo de Puerto Rico (American Red Cross in Puerto Rico) for Haiti, after that country was hit by a devastating earthquake last month.

The check was presented on January 28, 2010 by John T. Riordan, ICSC Foundation Board member and ICSC’s past president and CEO, during the Puerto Rico Idea Exchange, ICSC’s annual, regional conference in Puerto Rico. “It gives me great pleasure to present this check to the American Red Cross, for the country of Haiti in the wake of this terrible disaster,” said Riordan.
