LEND LEASE WINS ICSC FOUNDATION EUROPEAN COMMUNITY SUPPORT AWARD

New York, April 7, 2011 – The International Council of Shopping Centers (ICSC) Foundation is pleased to announce that Lend Lease of Kent, United Kingdom has been named the 2011 European Community Support Award winner for their “The Learning Shop, Bluewater” campaign. Ann Komzolik of North West Kent College, a partner in the creation of the program, accepted the award on behalf of Lend Lease. The award was presented last evening at the Solal Marketing Awards ceremony during ICSC’s European Marketing Conference in Istanbul, Turkey.

Lend Lease partnered with North West Kent College and Jobcentre Plus to create The Learning Shop, a unique on-site recruitment and training facility that specializes in retail, customer service, and recruitment. In the last 12 months, the Learning Shop created employment for 4,000 individuals, trained 500, and awarded over 375 qualifications. Approximately 70% of the people that benefited were from the local community.

As the winner of the Foundation’s European Community Support Award, Lend Lease will be eligible for the Foundation’s 2011 Albert Sussman International Community Support Award, which honours the best community support program worldwide. In addition Lend Lease’s partnering charity, The Learning Shop, will receive a \$5,000 USD donation from the ICSC Foundation.

The Foundation’s Community Support Award program, established in 2006, is a worldwide program that honours corporate social responsibility and community outreach efforts of shopping centers for charitable initiatives that enhance the communities that the retail real estate industry and its projects serve.
