FACTS AT A GLANCE

There are 180 shopping centres in Saskatchewan, one more than in 2000.

Sales Tax Revenue Is Up Again.

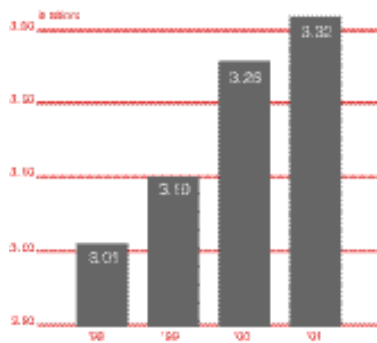
In 2001, employment in Saskatchewan shopping centres totaled 36,000, 10% of the province's total nonagricultural workers.

Saskatchewan shopping centres generated \$193 million in sales tax revenue in 2001, on \$3.32 billion in total retail sales. Nearly half, 47%, of Saskatchewan's total non-automotive retail sales took place in the centres in 2001.

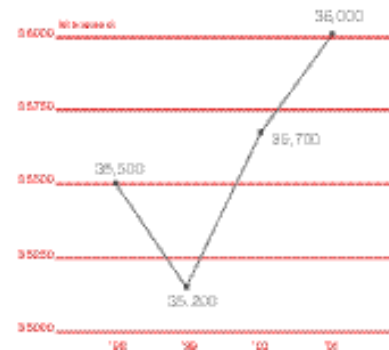
Saskatchewan has 11.2 million square feet of total leasable retail area. There was no new construction starts in the province in 2001.

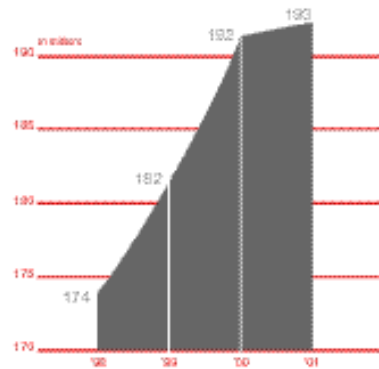
SHOPPING CENTRE SALES ARE RISING
