UP Express connects Toronto Pearson International Airport to Union Station in the heart of downtown Toronto (steps from the Metro Toronto Convention Centre) in just 25 stress-free minutes—less than half the time it often takes by car. Trains leave every 15 minutes with the first train departing Pearson Station at 05:27 and the last train departing at 00:57. There's no easier or more convenient way to get to or from Toronto Pearson.

The UP Express pulls directly into Toronto Pearson International Airport, Canada's largest and busiest airport.

Located in Terminal 1, directly adjacent to the Link Train service linking Terminals 1 and 3, the UP Express Pearson Station extends a warm welcome and fond farewell to millions of passengers each year. Our station has been thoughtfully designed to match high standards of an easy journey in a beautiful environment. We looked to the majestic landscapes of Ontario to inspire the architectural details of the station.

The Pearson Station service counter is in the International Arrivals hall of Terminal 1. Tickets can be bought in advance online, at GO stations and also purchased using PRESTO

The Union Pearson Express downtown terminal is located right within Canada's busiest rail hub – Union Station.

The UP Express stop at Union Station can be easily found within the interior Skywalk walkway. Guest service representatives will be happy to help you at the customer service desk with any questions.

For guests continuing their journey, local connections to the TTC subway and streetcar lines, as well as GO Transit regional bus and train lines are an easy transfer away. For guests staying downtown, Union Station is located in the bustling heart of downtown, close to hotels, restaurants, tourist attractions and business centres in the Financial and Entertainment districts.
